Seeks less volatile approach to invest in small cap companies.

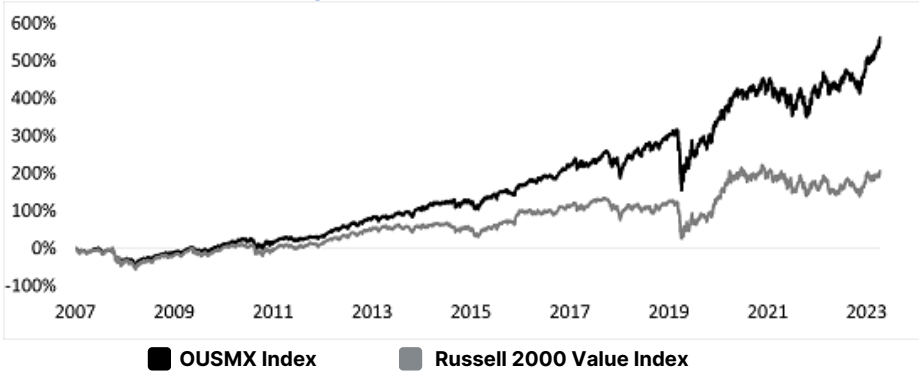
Use as Core Holding

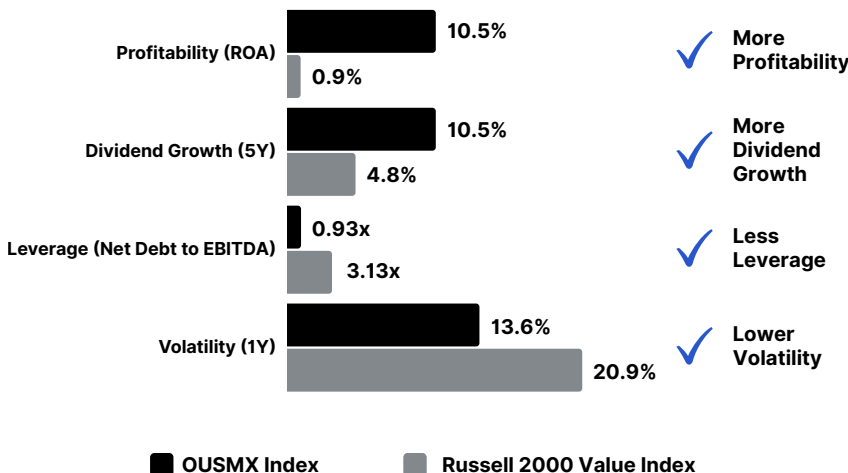
