OGIG is an exchange traded fund (ETF) that seeks to track the performance (before fees and expenses) of the O'Shares Global Internet Giants Index ("OGIG Target Index").

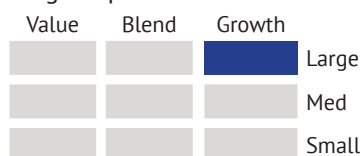

Index Methodology

The O'Shares Global Internet Giants Index (Ticker: OGIGX) is a rules-based index intended to give investors a means of tracking stocks exhibiting quality and growth characteristics in the internet technology and e-commerce business segments and pass screens for gross margin and cash burn sustainability.

Companies included in OGIGX derive the majority of their revenues from a) internet technology companies whose principal business is to provide the technologies that support internet commerce; and b) internet commerce companies whose principal business is to sell products and services via the internet.
